Discipline reports:

Air rifle – director – Lee Sancoy – There were 12 shooters last month, and attendance is increasing. Matches are held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of the month.

.22 Trail walk – director – Lee Sancoy – There were 9 shooters in attendance and it was a good day. Matches are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month at 5:30pm.
