New News:

Earlier this week the Oregon State Police (OSP) was notified by the Secretary of State the implementation of BM114 will be on December 8th. The Oregon State Police indicated they would be working with the Department of Justice on next steps. See a capture of the OSP post here..

This means, without intervention or processes put in place, firearms sales and transfers will stop on December 8th. At the time of writing it is uncertain what will happen with the purchases in the OSP background check queue on Dec. 8th.
