Discipline Reports

Air Rifle – Dempsey Voss – this was a good match, with several targets and lasted about 4 hours.

Black Powder – Darrel Plank – Will be held July 9th, 300 yard range, will be silhouette targets and annual BBQ.

Cowboy Action – Ron Mudie – last monthly shoot had 10 shooters in attendance.

.22 Long Range Silhouette – Darrel Plank – there were 13 shooters in attendance and Dave Bingner won the match.

Ground Hog and Egg Shoot – Dick Hohstadt – there were 5 shooters in attendance and the match was won by Marley Parks. Shooters had 5 eggs to shoot at 340 yards.

Sheldon Strand is beginning to work on grants for the club to apply for.

Darrel Plank will begin to prep to erect the flag pole at the 300 yard range. Placement for the flag was discussed.

President Plank found a 48-foot trailer to be used by the Cowboy Action shooters at the 100 yard (River) range. This will be used for storage.

New Business

The club received a 'thank you' from ODFW for giving permission allowing a survey of steelhead. The survey will be held next year due to the river's water level.

People have contacted the Oregon Trail Trader to ask for the code to the gates at the ranges. Karl Baum has a list of the membership, and unless the caller's name appears on the list, the code will not be given.
