In our last session we updated ranges on BM114 status and the next actions. We also approved a sum up to \$10,000 for donation to the Oregon Sportsmen Opposed to Gun Violence (OSOGV) group, once critical supporting information on future goals are published. We are still working with the group to ensure your funds are put to the best use.

The federal court cases are preparing. An amicus brief has been submitted by several organizations in the Sportsmen's group. Note that OSOGV, NSSF, OSSA, and OASR are not included on the brief as they are either directly or indirectly connected to the court case or parties of the court case. The amicus brief needs to be an independent input to the legal process and not connected to the plaintiffs or defendants. OSOGV could not participate since NSSF contributed to the formation of the group. We felt OASR should not, just to be safe, as there is overlap in the officers of OSSA and OASR. Additional amicus briefs are being submitted in our favor from minority and other special interest groups.

There are 3 Amicus Briefs filed in favor of our position. Note that included in these briefs, opposing BM114, are the very groups the proponents said supported the measure. The truth is out. See them at www.ossa.org/bm114

The State AG filed a petition with the Oregon Supreme Court to overturn Judge Raschio's stay on BM114. Here is an article.
