MINUTES OF MEETING

August 4, 2021

The August 4, 2021 meeting of the La Grande Rifle and Pistol Club (the “Club”) was called to order at 7:02 pm by President Karl Baum at the Anderson-Perry Conference Room in La Grande, OR. 10 individuals attended the meeting, including the following members of the 2021 **Executive Committee (EC)**: Karl Baum, Dick Hohstadt, Darrel Plank, Catherine Parks and **Trustees (BOT)** Gene Paul, Tim Roberts and Dutch Brogoitti, and Membership Director Cindy Edwards.

All present stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

Old Business:

-Membership: Cindy provided a report that the current membership total is 439, and 52 associate memberships.

-Treasurer Report: Karl presented a current Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss report for discussion. Noted was income of approximately \$58,000, the report is not super clear and we will be working to refine as the year progresses, bottom line, “we have money.”

-Work day: A range Work Day is still on schedule for August 21.

-Range Maintenance:

-Grinding of raised edges of concrete slabs at 300-yard range, has been looked at by Jaime Challis and an estimate will be sent to Dutch Brogoitti for him to review.

-Quarterly Newsletter: Karl provided a draft of the Third Quarter newsletter for review and distribution to members.

-Orientation Video: Karl reports that the Orientation Video is fully filmed and we should have a draft late next week.

-TAWW: requests to change dates for upcoming events, check the Calendar.

-Signage: Dutch has taken a list of all the signage we will need and will be working to get new signs made for the year. “Fire Equipment” “Range Closed” “No Trespassing” “Safety Zone” “No Hunting” “1st Aid Zone” “Range Closed due to Weather”

-Traditional Archers: Karl has been in contact with the Traditional Archer entourage and they had a minor correction to the Memo of Understanding submitted to them, they will be needing the 300-yard range in addition to the 100-yard range. The GBA will not be shooting as they will be shooting the week end before. No objection was noted from any of the attendees.

New Business:

-Fire Prevention: Karl reports that he has had several conversations with the ODF and they provided 6 bladder bags and some very detailed insight for fire prevention. The Club has already done the majority of the advised items with the only addition being if the Fire Season gets worse they may close during the Red Flag hours, or Noon to dusk. More to follow depending on the how the year progresses.

GBA: The GBA has requested to change the August shoot to just Sunday, no issues were noted. For the Nationals they are requesting a contract that requires the LGRPC to provide notification to our members, notification via Facebook and the website. No issues were noted by any of the members.
