January 3, 2024

OLD BUSINESS:

- **Treasurer Report:** Martin presented a current Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss report for discussion. It was noted that the annual audit will take place next month. Discipline directors are requested to submit their budgets for 2024 calendar year.

- **Membership:** Cindy reports membership records include: 459 current members, 64 associate members. There are currently 523 current card holders. 33 members moved to expired status. Noted was a total of 36 new membership applications within the last 30 days.
